2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 43  
3 represented in the General Assembly: 44

4 Section 3. The State Employees Group Insurance Act of 47  
5 1971 is amended by changing Section 6.11 as follows: 48

7 Sec. 6.11. Required health benefits; Illinois Insurance 53  
8 Code requirements. The program of health benefits shall 55  
9 provide the post-mastectomy care benefits required to be  
10 covered by a policy of accident and health insurance under 56  
11 Section 356t of the Illinois Insurance Code. The program of 57  
12 health benefits shall provide the coverage required under 58  
13 Sections 356u, 356w, and 356x of the Illinois Insurance Code.  
14 The program of health benefits must comply with Section 59





