Illinois Department of Insurance Disciplinary Report for May 2016

SPRINGFIELD – July 22, 2016. The Illinois Department of Insurance today announced the following disciplinary actions:

Revocation:

Elizabeth J. Thomas, Chicago – A Director's Order from hearing #15-HR-0883, signed May 4, 2016, sustained the Order of Revocation from October 21, 2015. Ms. Thomas had been licensed to sell health and life insurance since 2012. Ms. Thomas was revoked after an investigation revealed a prior felony conviction, failure to report the conviction as required by the Illinois Insurance code, and obtaining a license through misrepresentation or fraud.

Suspension:

Richard A. Moss, Palatine – Insurance producer's license suspended effective May 1, 2016. Mr. Moss had been licensed to sell casualty, fire, health, and life insurance since 2008. The suspension was based on a certification from the Department of Healthcare and Family Services that Mr. Moss was more than 30 days delinquent in complying with a child support order.
